Lizzy the Ice-cream Cone

It's always perfect weather for Lizzy, the lone researcher at the Astral Cone Observatory perched above the fjords. This ice-cream astronomer is studying a massive rip in space-time hovering over Sweet City. Her telescope readings suggest it's multidimensional—and possibly tangled with a second object, one native to our universe but not to Goomia. Curious indeed. No doubt Lizzy will be up late, melting over the data as she tries to un-scoop the mystery.

Louie's Notes: There were some unique problems to solve when I was designing this pattern, and I also couldn't imagine crocheting an ice-cream cone without an adorable hidden body, which added a few extra things to figure out. I'm especially happy with the stitching on the cake cone, which produces a unique texture that I'll be sure to use in future designs!



Materials

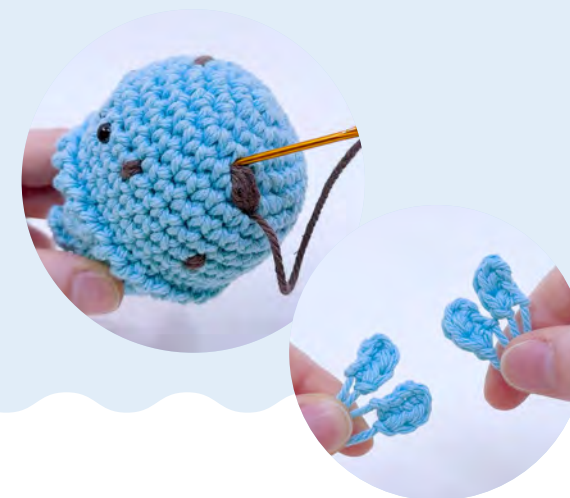
- Worsted (aran) weight yarn in the following shades:

- Cyan [C] (ice cream)
- Jute [J] (cone)
- Red [R] (cherry) *optional
- Brown [B] (chocolate chips) *optional

- Hook: size G/6 (4mm)
- Safety eyes: 6mm x 2
- Stuffing
- Darning needle
- Black thread or yarn for embroidery

Size

Approx. 5in (12.7cm) tall



Pattern

Ice-cream Top

Using Cyan, make a magic loop.

Rnd 1: sc 6 into the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st (12)

Rnd 3: [sc 1, inc] 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: [sc 2, inc] 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: [sc 7, inc] 3 times (27)

Rnd 6: [sc 8, inc] 3 times (30)

Rnds 7–10: sc in each st (30 for 4 Rnds)

Rnd 11: [sc 8, invdec] 3 times (27)

Rnd 12: working in the FLO, [ch 2, slst 1] in each st (27 frills)

Add the face at around Rnd 8 on the opposite side to the end of the rnds. Insert safety eyes and embroider a mouth using black thread or yarn.

Cut the yarn and pull through at this point if you want to make a simple ice-cream top. You can stuff this and sew it to your cone or sew to another ice-cream scoop for a multilevel ice cream!

See the instructions below if you want to add the hidden Ice-cream body.

Embroider on chocolate chips using Brown yarn on a needle.

Hidden Ice-cream Body

Continuing from the Ice-cream Top.

Rnd 13: Pull a loop through the unused BLO from Rnd 11, working in the unused BLO, [sc 7, sc2tog] 3 times (24)

Rnd 14: [sc 2, invdec] 6 times (18)

Rnd 15: [sc 5, inc] 3 times (21)

Rnds 16–17: sc in each st (21 for 2 Rnds)

Rnd 18: [sc 5, invdec] 3 times (18)

Partially stuff.

Rnd 19: [sc 1, invdec] 6 times (12)

Rnd 20: invdec in each st (6)

Stuff fully, cut the yarn, and pull through. Sew closed.

Embroider on a butt using black thread for bonus points.



Arms and Legs (make 4)

Using Cyan, ch 4.

Row 1: skip 2 chs, hdc in the last 2 chs (2 hdc)

Ch 1, cut the yarn, and pull through. Use the two tail ends to sew onto the front of the body.

Cherry (optional)

Using Red, make a magic loop.

Rnd 1: sc 6 into the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st (12)

Rnd 3: sc in each st (12)

Rnd 4: [sc 2, invdec] 3 times (9)

Pull through and cut the yarn.

To make a stem, cut the yarn and pull the center tail end upward through the center of the beginning magic loop. Knot the tail at the desired length and cut the yarn neatly. You could apply watered-down PVA glue or starch to the tail end to help the stem to stick straight up.

If you want to, add eyes and a mouth into Rnd 3.

Sew the cherry onto the top of your ice-cream!

Cone Lid

The cone lid is meant to be sewn inside the ice-cream cone to add stability. Make it before beginning either cone option.

Using Jute, make a magic loop.

Rnd 1: sc 6 into the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st (12)

Rnd 3: [sc 1, inc] 6 times (18)

Cut the yarn and hide the yarn tail. Sew this onto the inside of the cone (see cone pattern for detailed instructions).

Cake Cone

Using Jute, make a magic loop.

Rnd 1: sc 6 into the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st (12)

Rnd 3: [sc 1, inc] 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: working in the FLO, slst in each st (18)

Moss stitch is used for Rnds 5–12 to create a textured handle for the cone. This is done by alternating: ch 1 and skip a stitch, then sc 1 in the ch space from the previous Rnd. See video (page 7 for link to video) for detailed instructions. Alternatively, you can replace this with just an sc in each st for a more simplified cone.

Rnd 5: working in the unused BLO from Rnd 3, slst in first st, ch 1, sc in next, [ch 1, skip a st, sc in next] continue all the way around, ch 1 (19 sc and chs)

Rnds 6–12: [sc 1 in the ch-1 space (under the chain) from the previous Rnd, ch 1 and skip the sc st from the previous rnd]. Repeat this for 7 Rnds (19 for 7 Rnds)

Rnd 13: working in the chs and both loops, sc in each st (19)

Rnd 14: working in the FLO, [sc 3, inc] 4 times, sc 2, inc (24)

Rnd 15: slst 1, ch 1, working in the BLO starting in the same st as the slst, sc in each st (24)

Rnd 16: [sc 7, inc] 3 times (27)

Rnds 17–19: sc in each st (27 for 3 Rnds)



Rnd 20: slst in each st (27)

Cut the yarn and pull through. Hide this end into the first slst made.

Sew the cone lid into the unused BLO sts from Rnd 13. Make sure to stuff fully before finishing.

Place your ice-cream into the cone and enjoy!

Sugar Cone

This cone is meant as a more beginner friendly ice-cream cone, and is much easier to make than the cake cone but it doesn't stay upright by itself.

Using Jute, make a magic loop.

Rnd 1: sc 6 into the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: [sc 1, inc] 3 times (9)

Rnd 3: sc in each st (9)

Rnd 4: [sc 2, inc] 3 times (12)

Rnd 5: sc in each st (12)

Rnd 6: [sc 3, inc] 3 times (15)

Rnd 7: sc in each st (15)

Rnd 8: [sc 4, inc] 3 times (18)

Rnd 9: sc in each st (18)

Work in the FLO for the next rnd if you're including the cone lid. Sew the lid onto the unused BLO after Rnd 9. Don't forget to stuff slightly!

Rnd 10: [sc 5, inc] 3 times (21)

Rnd 11: sc in each st (21)

Rnd 12: [sc 6, inc] 3 times (24)

Rnd 13: sc in each st (24)

Rnd 14: [sc 7, inc] 3 times (27)

Rnds 15–16: sc in each st (27 for 2 Rnds)

Slst in next st, cut the yarn, and hide the end.

Place your ice-cream into the cone and enjoy!
